

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING:

1. **Progress Report of the year 2015-16:** Mr. Himanshu Juyal the organizing Secretary of the organization welcomed the presence and then read the report. He thanked all the members and donors specially the Patron Smt. Veena Juyal and the president Sh. Chandra Shekhar Juyal for their tremendous support to the organization because without the massive financial and moral support Parivartan Public School could not be started. There is no grant of help from anywhere rather the school has completed its first year with 25 students and now running its second session. He requested all the members and donors to continue their support to the organization because without their support the organization cannot run a single pace.

2. Drinking Water and Sanitation Program:

The organization has also worked in the planning phase work of Ghurdauri Pumping drinking water scheme with Uttarakhand Pevajal Nigam, Pauri. The work of Planning Phase has been completed in due time. Under NRDWP three gravity drinking water schemes Falswari, Jahajhar and Semli of Kot block are also in progress. Scheme of Falswari has been completed and rest two is in progress.

3. Empowering the Farmers and Sustainable Conservation of Natural Resources:

A new project UNDP-COMDEKS has been sanctioned to the organization on 29th of December, 2015. The work of the programme started on 1st January 2016 but the first installment received during May, 2016. This is Empowering poor and marginalized farmers of 10 hilly villages and sustainable conservation of natural resource of Pauri Garhwal. In this project migration from villages due to shortage of employment and low yield from agriculture is raised. Wild animal's interference is another main cause of leaving traditional agro activities. The decreasing rain or over raining, drought like condition of seasons are another issues of the area. In this programme water conservation and a forestation, spices production, mini dairy and low emission chulha under conventional energy are proposed. The time frame of the project upto 31st, October 2016 which is very short.

4. Days Celebration and Awareness Program:

The organization duly organized all the important days of the nation at Parivartan Public School and performed awareness programmes regularly in he society.

5. School Health Camps:

The organization organized its school health camps at its campus. The health team of The Hans Foundation participated the program. The children are given deworming medicines etc.

9. Budget for the year 20216-2017:

As per requirement of the organization all the members have been working voluntarily but if they work in certain projects they are paid according to the respective project work as the organization paid to its members in SWAp programme according to respective work done in the project. Now in UNDP project they will get payment as per project plan.

The organization has started its formal education programme under the banner of Parivartan Public School. The main expenditures are in this activity. There are more than 14 employees so salary of employees and other requirements will have to be managed. The fee will be one part of the expenditures but will not fulfill the demand of complete year. The transportation to pick and to drop back students from various destinations is another problem because without this service no students can reach to school. The organization is trying to provide such facilities of education so migration from the area could be curtailed or minimize.

The sanctioned amount of the Project is Rs. 1786000, it may be varied according to dollar value. The project is for the empowering the poor and marginal farmers of 10 hilly villages and sustainable conservation of natural resources of Pauri Garhwal.

The school programme will require vehicle for transporting the students so near about 500000 rupees will be required for the second hand vehicle in which more than 30 students can be carried out. The money is urgently required for the same.

3. Recognition of the School:

As the organization had applied to the school authority of the state of Uttarakhand for recognition up to upper primary level but since July 2015 it is pending and again needed. The president Sh. C. S. Juyal is requested by the house to accelerate the matter for the recognition of the school in due time.

4. Agricultural Machines:

In the meeting Mr. C.S. Juyal put a suggestion to arrange a mini tractor with all available accessories of plowing, carrying and like that to avail the facilities to the marginal farmers of area of Kot block, Pauri because now days there are acute shortage of bulls to plow the fields and the process is so lethargic and costly. A request may be put before agriculture department Pauri to avail the grant for the same. The machine's facilities will be provided to all required farmers of the area at the lowest cost of the service. All the members agreed this suggestion and requested the president to precede the matter to the concerned department.

In the last Mr. President addressed the house and thanked all the members of the organization for their dedication to the society because the society is regularly perishing, villages are becoming ruined, agriculture and other activities in the area are diminishing regularly, water resources are regularly decreasing. So result is migration from the area. The President adjourned the meeting.
