



## Parivartan Post-Matric Scholarship Program (2020-21)

The Parivartan Post-Matric Scholarship Program is a merit-cum-means based scholarship scheme for the meritorious and economically backward students of Pauri district studying at the senior secondary level.

This scheme is announced with a view to assisting the meritorious students of Pauri district who belong to economically backward sections of society.

### Eligibility Criteria

- You must be resident of Pauri district
- You must be pursuing studies at the Senior-Secondary level in Pauri district.
- The family income of your family should not be more than INR 2.5 Lakh
- You must complete the questionnaire

Besides this, marks obtained in previous classes will be considered.

### Awards & Benefits

Winner will receive a scholarship of **INR 20,000 per annum to maximum of INR 60,000** for payment towards tuition fees/hostel for higher studies in college/university.

Payment will be made directly to college/university towards tuition fees.

### How to apply

Step 1: Complete Application Form

Step 2: Complete Questionnaire

Step 3: Provide supporting documents

Step 4: Apply for respective college/university and obtain admission/acceptance letter

Step 5: NGO will pay the tuition fees directly to the institution on your behalf.

## Supporting documents

While you apply for the scholarship, you necessarily need to support your application with some mandatory documents:

- Mark sheets of last examination passed
- Income proof (salary/income tax return/income certificate/affidavit)
- Admission proof in the college/university
- Identity proof/Aadhar
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## Selection Process

Parivartan Scholarship Program is merit-cum-means based scholarship. It takes both your academic merit and financial need into consideration for the selection process.

## Renewal

Every year, the winners of Scholarship Program must apply for its renewal. The renewal cases are subject to your decent academic performance. The minimum score for renewal that you should obtain at the promotional level during transition from senior secondary level to under graduate level is 60% marks. Furthermore, you should pass/clear all semester examinations in the first attempt to be eligible for renewal.

Winner is required to submit mark sheet of first and second semester for next year renewal.
